
Before you start

Included in this kit: New trigger and wiring harness

Tools Needed:

T10 Star Driver with a minimum 6-inch shaft

T15 Star Driver with a minimum 6-inch shaft

STEP 1

Wand Disassembly - Side

Place the wand on a flat surface with the screw holes facing upwards. Using the T10 Star driver, remove the 7 screws holding the wand together.

STEP 2

Wand Disassembly - Front

Turn the wand opening towards you and remove only the top 2 screws using the T10 star driver.



STEP 3 Wand Disassembly - Back

With the wand still lying on its side, rotate it so that the fan is facing you and remove only the top 2 screws from the fan guard using the T15 Star driver.




STEP 4 Wand Separation

Once all the screws are removed, gently separate the top portion of the wand from the bottom. Keep in mind that the 2 halves are also connected by wires so do not try and completely pull them apart, instead slide the top half over to the side.



Trigger Switch Plug



STEP 5 Current Trigger Switch Removal

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Remove the trigger switch from the wand half and then, using a small screw driver or one of the screws you removed earlier, gently depress the locking mechanism that plugs the wires of the trigger switch into the board and remove the switch.



STEP 6 New Trigger Switch Installation

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Plug the new trigger switch into the board and place into the slot that holds the trigger in place.

When finished, reassemble the unit by following the reverse order of the disassembly instructions.
